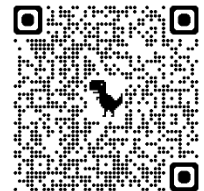
Èske TPS pou Ayiti toujou ap fini an?

Pou kounye a, Eitati Pwoteksyon Tanporè (TPS) pou Ayiti toujou an vigè. Depatman Sekirite Entèn (DHS) te gen plan pou mete fen nan TPS pou Ayiti **3 Fevriye 2026**, men yon jij federal te bloke revokasyon sa a nan dat **2 Fevriye 2026**. Akòz lòd jij la, TPS pou Ayiti ap kontinye pou kounye a. DHS te di li pa dakò ak lòd tribinal la epi li pral pwobableman fè apèl kont desizyon an.

FAQ: Is Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for Haiti Ending

Is TPS for Haiti still ending?

For now, Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for Haiti is still in effect. The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) had planned to end Haiti TPS on **February 3, 2026**, but a federal judge blocked that termination on **February 2, 2026**. Because of the judge's order, TPS for Haiti continues for now. . DHS has said it disagrees with the court order and will likely appeal the decision.

What does the court decision mean for me as a Haiti TPS holder?

You can **continue living and working in the United States with TPS protections** for the time being. You can check the [USCIS website](#) for updates on the case or read the federal judge's order directly.

Please keep in mind: Although TPS remains active today, **the situation could change** depending on future court decisions.



Is my work permit (EAD) still valid?

Yes. Because of the federal court decision, your TPS work permit is **still valid** if it shows any of the following original expiration dates:

You **do not** need to apply for a new card unless USCIS issues new instructions.

Do I need to do anything right now?

At this time:

- Since Haiti TPS could still be ended in the future, **if you may qualify for another form of immigration relief, it is recommended that you seek legal help.**

- You **do not** need to re--register for Haitian TPS with USCIS.
- You **do not** need to apply for a new EAD, unless USCIS provides new guidance.
- Keep checking the [Haitian Bridge Alliance website](#) for updates on the court case. HBA has also prepared a [letter you can share with employers](#) explaining the court order.



Remember: Legal support is essential. You can contact a private immigration attorney or a non-profit immigration legal service provider to understand their options.
