Mizajou Enpòtan: Kou Siprèm Etazini deside nan dat 25 jen 2026, gouvènman an ka kontinye ak pwosesis pou fini ak Eitati Pwoteksyon Tanporè (TPS) pou Ayiti. Yo prevwa TPS Ayiti a ap fini nan zòn 27 jiyè 2026, sof si yon tribinal enferyè pran yon lòt desizyon anvan sa.

Dapre dènnye enstriksyon USCIS ak E-Verify bay, pèmi travay ki gen rapò ak TPS oswa Dokiman Otorizasyon pou Travay (EAD) ki aktyèl yo pwolonje jiska 24 jiyè 2026, men se sèlman yon mezi tribinal la bay pou yon tan limite, pandan y ap tann desizyon final pwosè a.

Tanpri pran san w pou li enfòmasyon sa a byen epi pale ak yon avoka imigrasyon byen rapid pou diskite kijan chanjman sa yo ka afekte ou menm ak fanmi ou.

Èske TPS pou Ayiti toujou ap fini an?

Pou kounye a, wi, yo prevwa TPS ap fini. Yon lòd tribinal te pwoteje TPS pou Ayiti depi mwa fevriye 2026. Nan dat 25 jen 2026, Kou Siprèm nan te bay gouvènman federal la rezon, sa ki louvri chemen pou fini ak TPS. Daprè desizyon sa a, yo prevwa TPS Ayiti ap fini nan zòn 27 jiyè 2026, sof si yon tribinal enferyè entèvni anvan sa.

Kisa desizyon tribinal la vle di pou mwen yon moun ki gen TPS Ayisyen?

Ou kapab kontinye viv epi travay Ozetazini sou proteksyon TPS pou kounye a. Ou ka al gade sou [Sitwèb USCIS](#) la pou wè dènnye enfòmasyon sou ka a.

Èske mwen bezwen fè yon bayay kounye a?

Pou kounye a:

- Ou ka kalifye pou yon lòt fòm opsyon legal nan zafè imigrasyon. Nou rekòmande anpil, pou ou konsilte yon avoka imigrasyon oswa yon reprezantan legal akredite pou diskite sou opsyon ou yo.
- Ou **pa bezwen** enskri ankò pou TPS Ayisyen ak USCIS.
- Ou **pa bezwen** aplike pou yon nouvo EAD, sof si USCIS ba ou nouvo direktiv.

FAQ: Is Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for Haiti Ending?

Note: *This is general information only and should not be considered legal advice.*

Important Update: The U.S. Supreme Court ruled on June 25, 2026, that the government may move forward with ending Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for Haiti. Haiti TPS is expected to terminate around July 27, 2026, unless a lower court decides something different before then.

According to updated guidance from USCIS and E-Verify, current TPS-related work permits or Employment Authorization Documents (EAD) have been extended to July 24, 2026, only as a limited court-ordered relief while the remaining litigation is resolved.

Please read this carefully and talk to an immigration lawyer as soon as possible to discuss how these developments can affect you and your family.

Is my TPS still valid?

For now, yes, but it is expected to end. A court order had protected Haiti TPS since February 2026. On June 25, 2026, the Supreme Court sided with the federal government, clearing the way for TPS termination. Based on that ruling, Haiti TPS is expected to terminate around **July 27, 2026**, unless a lower court intervenes before then.

What does the court decision mean for me as a Haiti TPS holder?

At this time, you can **continue to live and work in the United States under your TPS protections**. You can check the [USCIS website](#) for updates on the case.

Please keep in mind: Although TPS remains in effect today, **the situation could change** depending on future court actions.



Is my work permit (EAD) still valid?

Yes. Your work permit remains valid through **July 24, 2026**, if the original expiration date printed on your work permit card is one of the following:

- Feb. 3, 2026
- Aug. 3, 2025
- Aug. 3, 2024

- June 30, 2024
- Feb. 3, 2023
- Dec. 31, 2022
- Oct. 4, 2021
- Jan. 4, 2021
- Jan. 2, 2020
- July 22, 2019
- Jan. 22, 2018
- July 22, 2017

You do not need to get a new card right now. Watch for USCIS updates after July 10, 2026, for updates regarding work authorization and any additional steps that may be required.

Do I need to do anything right now?

At this time:

- You may qualify for another form of immigration relief. It is strongly recommended that you consult with an immigration attorney or accredited legal representative to discuss your options.
- You **do not** need to re--register for Haitian TPS with USCIS at this time.
- You **do not** need to apply for a new EAD unless USCIS provides new guidance.
- Keep checking the [Haitian Bridge Alliance website](#) for updates on the court case and any changes that may affect TPS holders. HBA has also prepared a [letter you can share with employers](#) explaining the court order and employment authorization situation.



Remember: Legal support is essential during this period of uncertainty. You can contact a private immigration attorney or a non-profit immigration legal service provider to understand their options.
